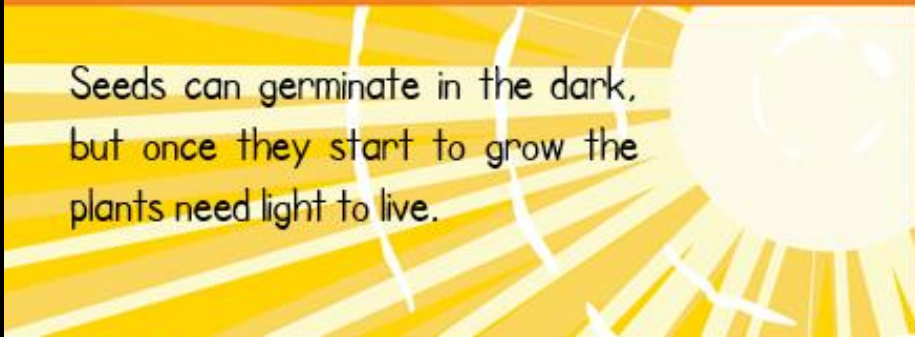

Dispersal

Some plants are carnivores! They get nutrients by eating insects. One example is the Venus Fly Catcher.



Seeds can germinate in the dark, but once they start to grow the plants need light to live.



Parts of a Plant

Flower



The flower makes seeds to grow new plants.

Stem



The stem holds the plant up and carries water and nutrients from the soil to the leaves.

Leaves



The leaves make food for the plant using sunlight and carbon dioxide from the air.

Roots



The roots anchor the plant into the ground and absorb water and nutrients from the soil.
