Message from the Headteacher

Dear Parents/Carers,

Now that the Government has announced that schools will open to certain year groups, from June 1st onwards, it is our intention to do so. Please see the dates that the year groups are returning next week. As you will see, it is a staggered start. This is to ensure that everyone knows what to do and when. Time slots have been sent out to parents who have informed us that their child is returning to school. If you have not received yours yet, please get in touch.

If you have not yet decided whether or not your child is returning, that is fine. However, if you change your mind and would like your child to attend school, you must inform us 1 week in advance of them starting, as it will take time to sort out groupings etc. We have a limit of 10 children per group. Once the maximum number has been reached, we will no longer be offering places. This follows our risk assessment, which will be published on the school website next week.

Staff will continue to put work for children to complete at home on to the virtual classrooms, on Microsoft Teams. If you would like to receive a paper copy of the work instead, please email me. In the meantime, keep safe and well.
