### Dates for your Diary

Last day of Summer term - Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July.

Start of Autumn term – Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> September (depending on the advice from Government about the reopening of schools).

Autumn Half term – Monday 26<sup>th</sup> October – Friday 30<sup>th</sup> October.

End of Autumn term – Friday 18<sup>th</sup> December.

Start of Spring term 2021 – Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January.

### ***What to do if your child develops COVID19 symptoms***

A child that develops any of the following symptoms should immediately self-isolate:

- a new continuous cough and/or;
- a fever (temperature of 37.8°C or higher);
- a loss of or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia).

They ***must not attend school*** and parents/carers should follow the steps below:

- Stay at home;
- Notify school;
- Arrange a test.
