Teams Classrooms – How to log on

To access the online lessons, please follow steps below:

1. Log into RM Unify – bromhillsdudley.rmunify.com
2. Log into your child's account (Remember – the username is your child's last name and the first letter of their first name, followed by @bromhills.dudley.sch.uk - for example: smittht@bromhills.dudley.sch.uk)
3. Type in your child's password (if you are not sure, please email school)
4. Once you have logged into RM Unify, you should be able to see a tile called Teams – click on this (the first time you do this, you might be prompted to sign into an account – use the school account and then type in your child's username, as above)
5. Hopefully, you will be able to see the Teams classes. Click on a class and then on the tab – assignments. Here you will find the work.
6. You will find a link to the lessons on 'Calendar' – click on the lesson when it is about to begin.
